SUBJECT: Awards and Decorations for PFC ROSELAND, CLARENCE E. 36 832 556

1. IAW AR 600-8-22, we have determined PFC Roseland is entitled to the Distinguished Service Cross (original general order, new certificate and citation enclosed), Bronze Star Medal (permanent order and certificate enclosed), and Purple Heart (permanent order and certificate enclosed). Please note, the Bronze Star Medal is based on his prior award of the Combat Infantryman Badge (original general order enclosed). The enclosed memorandum for record also reflect his entitlement to these awards.
2. All pertinent documentation has been forwarded to the National Personnel Records Center for inclusion in PFC Roseland's reconstructed Army Military Human Resource Record.
3. We are only able to verify a single award of the Purple Heart, which is in relation to PFC Roseland's death. We do not possess official military documentation regarding a prior award of the Purple Heart. Should his family locate additional military documentation confirming he was wounded in action during an earlier qualifying wartime event, please forward copies to our office for review.
4. Please clarify whether medal sets should be ordered, or whether a full military awards listing is needed with respect to PFC Roseland. A copy of his Individual Deceased Personnel File would be required in this regard.

Award, posthumously, of the Distinguished-Service Cross I
Award of the Bronze Star Medal II

I - AWARD, POSTHUMOUSLY, OF THE DISTINGUISHED-SERVICE CROSS. By direction of the President, under the provisions of Army Regulations 600-45, 22 September 1943, as amended, the Distinguished-Service Cross is awarded, posthumously, by the Army Commander to the following named individual:

CLARENCE E. ROSELAND, 36 832 556, Private First Class, Infantry, Company "H", 179th Infantry Regiment, for extraordinary heroism in action on 6 October 1944, near Grandvillers, France. When his company was ordered to withdraw to a better defensive position, Private First Class Roseland remained behind and delivered deadly machine gun fire upon the attacking enemy forces. His courageous actions and complete disregard for his own personal safety enabled his company to withdraw safely to its new position and repulse the enemy in every assault. Private First Class Roseland gave his life in his action to insure the safety of his comrades. Next of Kin: Carrie Roseland, Mother, Melrose, Wisconsin.

II - AWARD OF THE BRONZE STAR MEDAL. By direction of the President, under the provisions of Army Regulations 600-45, 22 September 1943, as amended, the Bronze Star Medal is awarded by the Army Commander to the following named individuals:

LEONARD W. SICKENDICK, 37 390 368, Corporal, Infantry, 781st Tank Battalion, for meritorious service in direct support of combat operations from 15 February 1945 to 6 May 1945, in Germany.

WILLIAM L. TAYLOR, 37 388 838, Technician Fifth Grade, Infantry, 781st Tank Battalion, for meritorious service in direct support of combat operations from 15 February 1945 to 6 May 1945, in France, Germany and Austria. Entered military service from Missouri.
